Facilities Transition Task Force

The church's Board has appointed a facilities transition task force to look at space and other building needs to better facilitate our current and future ministries. Goals include creating space at the church of SCC offices, finding appropriate space (200 sq ft) for Peace Lutheran Offices and other multi-purposes spaces as identified. Ultimately, the plan is to eventually sell the rental properties on 19th and Wall.

Ministry leadership of such groups as worship, CWF/Hospitality, church administration and faith formation will be contacted for suggestions of what is needed, what they wish for and their ideas about what future needs may be.

Green Tip

Global Recycling Day is March 18. Most of the time, plastic is a great candidate for recycling. However, there are times when it needs to be thrown away. One of the easiest ways to determine whether plastic belongs in the recycling container or trash can is by using the "Poke Test." If you can push your finger through it, then the plastic is too soft to be recycled. Flimsy plastic gets tangled in the sorting machinery, causing expensive damage and extensive delays. So even if it says it's recyclable, things like water bottle wraps, grocery bags and bubble wrap all require special handing. You can take these items to the grocery store to be recycled.
