#### Pastor's Corner

An advertisement for a digital book caught my attention last week which has turned into the focus of sermons for the month of August. The book is entitled *Believe Like Jesus: Rising from Faith in Jesus to the Faith of Jesus*, by Rebekah Simon-Peter. The point is to move away from believing in Jesus (theology) and engage in faithful practice like Jesus. It's actually a Lenten devotional, and when I began reading I realized I'm not completely fond of the author's choices for biblical examples, so I'm borrowing the idea and substituting the gospel lectionary passages for the month of August as the underlying scriptures. The outline is as follows:

August 24 Luke 13:10-17 "Liberation"

August 31 Luke 14:1, 7-14 "Hospitality"


