"Welcoming and accepting all people" – is a reminder of our Welcome Statement and genuine hospitality, in the present tense so it is always relevant. "along" – is an invitation to join together side by side, "journey of faith" – implies that arrival is a myth; we are always growing, "service" –is a natural outcome of faith and inseparable from our commitment to discipleship.

The Time Between Christmas and Lent at Sojourners CC -

Our General Minister and President, Rev. Terri Hord Owens has written to the church with a challenge to be the church we say we are. In her book published just last year, she reminds us of our roots and challenges us to deeper spirituality that transforms our ministries.

Here is one review of the book:

Tired of the division and hypocrisy in the church today? Discover a new vision for a church grounded in love, unity, and prophetic imagination that welcomes everyone to the table. This book will inspire you to become a catalyst for change and build a church that lives up to its calling.

In a world of increasing polarization, the church is called to be a beacon of hope and unity. Staying at the Table challenges us to confront injustice, embrace diversity, and live out the radical love of Christ. How do we have difficult conversations? How do we dream together of a more vibrant faith, a more energized faith

community, a better world? It starts with a church grounded in deep spiritual practice, Biblical engagement, and God's love and imagination. Staying at the Table is an essential guide for anyone who longs for a church ready to leave behind the tired, hollow words that have little impact on its community and to lean into an authentic faith that truly, deeply embodies the teachings of Jesus.

With an engaging forward by Disciple's minister Rev. William Barber II of the Moral Movement, it has been recommended to every congregation in the denomination as essential reading.

We will use the seven weeks between the Christmas and Lent season to consider one chapter each Sunday in worship as follows:

January 4 "Everything Begins with God" - Ephesians 3:20-21

January 11 "Start With Limitless Love" - 1 John 4:7-21

January 18 "Imagine With Me" - 1 Corinthians 1:25-28

January 25 "Let's Be the Church We Say We Are" - 2 Timothy 3:14-17

Copies of the book are available for purchase from Chalice Press or several other outlets if you want to read along and go deeper in your personal study.



With the passage of the 2026 Sojourners budget, we will now be setting aside 10% of receipts to the General Fund for outreach ministries on a weekly basis (as opposed to 9% previously).
