

Lent begins on Wednesday, February 18

As “sojourners” on a spiritual journey, a Lenten study focusing on scripture, reflection, and walking sounds right up our alley! In *Meeting Jesus on the Road*, we are invited to journey alongside Christ through the Gospel stories that define his earthly path. Gathering a group of disciples around him, Jesus travelled the region, teaching, healing, and proclaiming that the reign of God is at hand. He met them all with compassion. He brought them hope. From the Jordan River to the hills of Galilee and beyond, Jesus calls us—like the first disciples—to follow, listen, question, and grow.

Lent is a pilgrimage of forty days as we walk – mentally or physically – with Jesus as he reveals the world as God sees it and examine our response as followers. Each week, Colleen will use this resource to guide our adult Sunday School and worship and offer weekly suggested practices to help us dive deeper in reflection and growth. Beginning with Ash Wednesday when we prepare ourselves for the journey and throughout the season, walking will serve as our spiritual metaphor for following Jesus toward the cross and empty tomb. Each week we will also receive “Walking Prompts” that stimulate our thinking and compliment the weekly reflection and encourage full integration of mind, body, and soul. “Using images, metaphors, and lessons from the life and wanderings of Jesus and from the spiritual practices of pilgrimages and labyrinths, the authors will lead us on a Lenten journey that is engaging, exacting, and enlightening.” For those with mobility challenges, alternative modes of meditation and observation will be included.

The brief Ash Wednesday service will be in the Fellowship Hall at 6PM on February 18, allowing for a different kind of atmosphere to commission our journey. Then the following Sunday worship themes and scriptures will be as follows, and will be the same for Adult Faith Formation at 9:30am (Sunday School):

February 22 – Lent #1 “On the Road to Ministry” Matthew 4:12-17

March 1 – Lent #2 “Grounded in Prayer” Matthew 6:5-15


March 8 – Lent #3 “Traveling Unattached” Luke 9:1-6

March 15 – Lent #4 “A New Allegiance” Mark 8:31-37

March 22 – Lent #5 “Decentering the Self” Mark 9:30-37

March 29 – Palm Sunday – “On the Way to the Cross” Mark 11:1-10

April 5 – Easter Sunday – “Back to the Beginning” Matthew 28:1-10



♦♦In preparation for this spiritual pilgrimage, the authors suggest that we read the entire Gospel of Mark and note how often Jesus changes locations. We have just enough time to read one chapter a day before the start of Lent. Let's do this!

Jan. 2026 Life Together Task Force Committee

At the Jan. 5 meeting, the Task Force heard from SCC Green Team Chair Cyndi Cogbill and endorsed her suggestion to have the church property identified as a Certified Wildlife Habitat. This is through the National Wildlife Federation's program for churches. Certification is a \$25 one-time fee, and some extra fees for signs. When certification is verified a joint celebration with both churches will be scheduled.

The Task Force will begin to identify ways for both congregations to be more intentional in joint fellowship activities to further encourage a spirit of collaboration and partnership.

Shoal Creek Conservation Education Center will host a native plant sale on *Saturday, May 23rd* starting at 10am. **SAVE THE DATE!**




